



## Things to know about changes to Washington Apple Health (Medicaid)

in Clallam County

### Changes are coming January 1, 2020 to Apple Health

*This change **will not reduce any benefits**. Apple Health (Medicaid) clients will continue to have access to all of the same services they currently do, but the state will pay for them differently.*

#### What's changing

Three Apple Health plans will be available in your county:

- Amerigroup
- Molina Healthcare
- United Healthcare

These plans will cover mental health, substance use disorder treatment, and physical health services. For individuals who also have Medicare, this applies to behavioral health only.

Beginning January 2020, Apple Health enrollees in Clallam county will be covered by one of the three plans above.

Two plans will not be available:

- Community Health Plan of Washington
- \*Coordinated Care

You will get a letter in December with the name of the health plan that will cover your services beginning January 1. You will have the option to change plans. The letter will explain how to do this.

Clients currently enrolled with Molina Healthcare do not need to make changes. They will continue enrollment with Molina automatically.
